- A concurrent request by the City of Maricopa to rezone the two-acre site from the existing General Rural (GR) zoning district to the Light Industrial (LI) zoning district.




### Site Location






## General Plan Map

### Public Comment(s)

- As required per the City Code.
- April 14, 2023 Notification letters went out to all local utilities.
- April 17, 2023 Public agencies were notified.
- April 18, 2023 Sign posting was posted on the subject site.
- April 29, 2023 Newspaper Notice published in the Casa Grande Dispatch.
- May 22, 2023 Public Hearing held at the Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting.
- No public comments were received at the time of the report provided to the Mayor and City Council.

### Staff Findings

Staff supports the rezoning request as it satisfies the following findings:

- The amendment is consistent with the General Plan,
- Any change in District boundaries is necessary to achieve the balance of land uses desired by the City, consistent with the General Plan, and to increase the inventory of land within a given zoning district,
- The amendment will promote the growth of the City in an orderly manner and protect the public health, safety, peace, comfort and general welfare.
