NARRATIVE

My name is Bruce Fennig. I have been a resident of Chandler, AZ for 16 years. I have been involved in the tree care industry for the past 16 years and have served on the board of directors of The Arizona Tree Council. I am a certified arborist, ISA, and have owned and operated a tree care company. I have sold the tree care company and am putting my efforts to create an outlet for the local tree care company's wood chips.

I am aware that most of the tree trimming are being put in the landfill and are a major cost to the tree care companies. This is a waste of a good asset that can be recycled and cut costs for the tree owner.


My operation gathers the tree trimmings in Phoenix and surrounding landscape businesses. Then we sort out the usable from the unusable particles and chunks. We then transport them to the yard in Maricopa and sort them further using a screener machine. This divides them into three different size particles, which then can be distributed to the various end users.


Our process does not include any added chemicals or manure, there is no smell and does not attract flies. We only use water to control dust and darken the material. We do not accept loose brush thereby minimizing fire hazard. Our process is totally organic and produces a superior product.

We want to be in total compliance of all local ordinances and laws, for the health and safety of the surrounding area. I have always followed the ANSI standards in the tree care industry and worked with OSHA and my insurance companies to make sure my customers and employees all have a good experience. The facility will be a state of the art facility with chips placed in straight rows with wide (20') clean isles for access. (See attached drawing of proposed facility.) We have a well and have adequate water supply. We occupy a total of five acres, located in the center of a 30 acre tract, that isn't near any residential areas and is only within 300 feet of an unused landfill. The three local dairies within tree miles may be an end user of our product. Currently The Scotts Company is our biggest customer. They are known for their focus on safety and quality.

The facility will be used to educate other people interested in the green waste recycling industry not only for the science but also the safest way to produce this planet-saving product. I will be starting a local association with the use of this facility. It will focus on safety using local fire departments and classroom education to obtain a certification.

We are helping to make tree maintenance more affordable and to recycle a valuable commodity. We need trees to breath and for our own mental health. This operation diverts over **6000 tons** of green waste annually from the landfill. Our product is used to grow new plants that clean and replenish the air we breathe. We will be available to recycle 100% of the city's green waste and help make Maricopa a totally "green" city. We have discussed it with the school system already and hope to work out an economical way of collecting and recycling all their green waste.



MEETING MINUTES #CUP 17-02

Meeting was called to order at 4pm at Maricopa library. Those in attendance was Bruce Fennig from Arizona Wood Grinding.

At 4:10 PM a gentleman, Brad Hinton arrived and joined the meeting.

He represented the Eldorado Holdings Inc. He stated they didn't have any major concerns, but had the property to the west under contract for purchase. The perspective buyers expressed concern over a fly issue they observed on their property last summer. They didn't know where they were coming from but didn't want it to effect their propose operation.

The only other issue they expressed was over the view from their property of the row of wood chips. They don't feel it is esthetically pleasing to their property.

I said that I felt the fly problem was probably due to the dairy periodically cleaning the pits and spreading manure. We don't use manure and should not attract large fly populations. The view has been discussed with the city officials and could be cured with the planting of oleanders along the property line, would not be an issue if the are going to construct a wall to secure their property.

I also invited the prospective investors to tour our operation to explain to them and belay any concerns. He said that would be a good idea and he would relay the invitation.

APPLICANTS RESPONSE TO CONCERNS

There was only one party that participated in the public meeting. They are actually over 300 feet from our operation and the center of the property is over ½ mile away according to the perspective buyers. The property owners are hoping to sell their property to investors. It is vacant at this time. While they have no real concerns, they are trying to maximize the sale price of their property and minimize any negative effects this operation may have on their sale price.

I was a certified real estate appraiser for the state of Ohio for seven years and can say in my opinion there should be no negative effect due to our remote location.

Our operation has no odor due to the fact we do not use any chemicals or manure. The fly population is similar to what is in you own backyard. We do not have heavy traffic or make any dust. We use only wood chips and water. Similar to if a tree falls in the forest – a natural process.

I invited the perspective buyers to our operation, which they have done. At their visit, they verified there was no odor and a minimal amount of flies. I would suggest that large fly populations appear at times the dairy is cleaning and spreading manure on the adjoining fields. I have a Bachelor of Science degree in agriculture from The Ohio State University and have spent some time studying dairies and dairy farms.

Our process will help recycle valuable resources and sequester carbon from the environment. We employ four people, some of which are residents of Maricopa. We also supply a large employer in Maricopa (Scotts) with a high quality reasonably priced raw material so they can be efficient.

We believe this a legal enterprise and do it to provide us with a small income and to help save the planet. This operation will be an asset to the city in the future, I have contacted the schools to start a green waste program. We could make the city of Maricopa 100% green.

REGULATORY BILL OF RIGHTS

This past legislative session (Fiftieth Legislature, First Regular Session), the Arizona Legislature passed Senate Bill 1598. This "Regulatory Bill of Rights" went into effect on July 20, 2011 (with full implementation on December 31, 2012). The rights afforded private regulated parties under the new law are provided below.

A.R.S. § 11-1602: REGULATORY BILL OF RIGHTS TO ENSURE FAIR AND OPEN REGULATION BY CITIES, A PERSON:

- IS ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF FEES AND OTHER EXPENSES IF THE PERSON PREVAILS BY ADJUDICATION ON THE MERITS AGAINST A CITY IN A COURT PROCEEDING REGARDING A CITY DECISION AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 12-348.
- IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE INFORMATION AND NOTICE REGARDING INSPECTIONS AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1603 (EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2012).
- IS ENTITLED TO HAVE A CITY NOT BASE A LICENSING DECISION IN WHOLE OR IN PART ON LICENSING CONDITIONS OR REQUIREMENTS THAT ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1604.
- MAY HAVE A CITY APPROVE OR DENY THE PERSON'S LICENSE APPLICATION WITHIN A
 PREDETERMINED PERIOD OF TIME AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1605 (EFFECTIVE DECEMBER
 31, 2012).
- IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE WRITTEN OR ELECTRONIC NOTICE FROM A CITY ON DENIAL OF A LICENSE APPLICATION (EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2012).
 - THAT JUSTIFIES THE DENIAL WITH REFERENCES TO THE STATUTE, ORDINANCE, REGULATION, DELEGATION AGREEMENT OR AUTHORIZED SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT ON WHICH THE DENIAL IS BASED AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1605.
 - THAT EXPLAINS THE APPLICANT'S RIGHT TO APPEAL THE DENIAL AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1605.
- IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE INFORMATION REGARDING THE LICENSE APPLICATION PROCESS AT THE TIME THE PERSON OBTAINS AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1606.
- MAY INSPECT ALL ORDINANCES, REGULATIONS, AND SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENTS OF A CITY, INCLUDING A DIRECTORY OF DOCUMENTS, AT THE OFFICES OF THE CITY AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1607.
- UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED, MAY EXPECT CITIES TO AVOID DUPLICATION OF OTHER LAWS THAT DO NOT ENHANCE REGULATORY CLARITY AND TO AVAOID DUAL PERMITTING TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PRACTICABLE AS PROVIDED IN A.R.S. § 11-1604.
- MAY FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE CITY COUNCIL CONCERNING AN ORDINANCE, REGULATION OR SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT THAT FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A.R.S. § 11-1602.
