1. Describe the contributions or services the organization has made to the Maricopa Community:

The Friends of the Library provide volunteers for our public library. Some of the volunteer duties include: shelving returned materials, assisting in checking in books, assisting with crafts and special programs and reading with children in the STAR reading program.

FOTL fundraising efforts provided over \$5,000 in financial assistance to the library during the past year. Some of the special programs that were coordinated and sponsored by the FOTL were: Summer and Winter Reading Programs, Dr. Seuss birthday party celebration, Star Wars' celebration, the Alice in Wonderland Tea Party, and the "Holiday Showcase" where each child made a holiday craft to take home.
