ORDINANCE NUMBER 18-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "2018 AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE 10-4 – ALARM SYSTEMS" BY REFERENCE AND AMENDING ARTICLE 10-4 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

- **WHEREAS**, on January 18, 2005, the City of Maricopa adopted an Alarm System Code as Article 10-4 of the City Code; and
- **WHEREAS**, that certain document known as "2018 Amendments to Article 10-4 Alarm Systems" was adopted as a public record by Resolution 18-22 on September 4, 2018; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that amending Article 10-4 of the Maricopa City Code would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa; and
- **WHEREAS**, A.R.S. §9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona as follows:
- **SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802, that certain document known as "2018 Amendments to Article 10-4 Alarm Systems" of the Maricopa City Code, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution 18-22 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** Article 10-4 of the Maricopa City Code and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in their entirety and replaced with the provisions set forth in the "2018 Amendments to Article 10-4 Alarm Systems" which was made public record by Resolution 18-22 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona.
- **SECTION 3**. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.
- **SECTION 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.
