## FIRST AMENDMENT TO TRIP HAZARD ELIMINATION SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO TRIP HAZARD ELIMINATION SERVICES ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October 2018, by and between the City of Maricopa, Arizona, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City"), and Precision Concrete Cutting, Inc., a Utah corporation d.b.a. Safe Sidewalks ("Contractor"), for Trip Hazard Elimination Services. ("Project").

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2017 the Maricopa City Council approved CON 17-46, an Agreement with Contractor for Trip Hazard Elimination Services ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend the Agreement to allocate funds for the second year of the agreement term.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties specifically agree to amend the Agreement dated September 19, 2017 as follows:

1. Section 3, <u>COMPENSATION</u>, shall be amended to reflect that in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement and this First Amendment, City shall compensate Contractor for its services as follows:

See attached Exhibit A and Exhibit B, which are attached to the Agreement.

In no event shall the total compensation under this Agreement for the second year, September 20, 2018 through September 19, 2019, exceed ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND and 00/100 Dollars (\$100,000.00). Exhausting the total amount payable for activities described herein shall not relieve Contractor of its obligations to perform such Services. Should City request additional Services beyond that specified herein, Contractor shall charge, and City shall pay, a rate as mutually agreed upon in writing prior to Contractor performing the additional Services.

3. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement are to continue in full force and effect as stated and agreed to in the Agreement dated September 19, 2017 as if fully set forth herein.
