ORDINANCE NUMBER 18-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "CHAPTER 3 ADMINISTRATION REVISED 2018" BY REFERENCE AS REVISED SECTIONS 3-1 THROUGH 3-282 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND REPEALING CHAPTER 3 OF THE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED CITY CODE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, that certain document known as the "Chapter 3 Administration Revised 2018" was adopted as a public record by Resolution No. 18-24 on October 2, 2018;

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2010, the City of Maricopa adopted Chapter 3 Administration as part of the City Code, which has been revised from time to time;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that repealing Chapter 3 and adopting Sections 3-1 through 3-282 would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802, that certain document known as "CHAPTER 3 ADMINISTRATION REVISED 2018" of the Maricopa City Code, electronic copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 18-24 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The previously adopted Chapter 3 of the Maricopa City Code and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in their entirety and replaced with "Chapter 3 Administration Revised 2018" which was made public record by Resolution No. 18-24 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona.

SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court

of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage and adoption.
