## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-13**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT FOR KEEPING TEACHERS TEACHING IF THEIR GRANT APPLICATION IS FUNDED BY THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY.

**WHEREAS,** The Gila River Indian Community disburses grant money to non-profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Gila River Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit's behalf; and

**WHEREAS,** Keeping Teachers Teaching is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that supports a high quality education by focusing on the well-being of the teachers molding the minds of children; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to agree to act as the designated fiscal agent for the grant application of Keeping Teachers Teaching for the National Youth Education Program.

**NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for Keeping Teachers Teaching if their grant application is funded by the Gila River Indian Community.
