## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-29**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE AGREEMENT AND APPLICATION TO COMPLY WITH ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES (ARS) TITLE 9, CHAPTER 13 RELATING TO UNIFORM REGULATION AND LICENSING OF VIDEO AND CABLE SERVICE PROVIDERS.

**WHEREAS**, in 2018, the State of Arizona approved Senate Bill 1140 (SB1140) which amended Title 9 of the Arizona Revised States by adding Chapter 13 relating to the uniform regulation and licensing of video and cable service providers; and

**WHEREAS**, SB1140 establishes the need for Uniform Video Service License Agreements, form, provisions and fees; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted a model Uniform Video Service License Agreement that was developed by a working group of Arizona municipalities in cooperation with industry stakeholders and the League of Arizona Cities and Towns; and

**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Video Service License Agreement and Application sets forth the rights-of-way use requirements and authorizes the installation, operation and maintenance of video services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, herby approves and adopts the Uniform Video Service License Agreement and Application in the form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.
