

RESOLUTION NO. 19-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR FUNDING BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF THE CASA GRANDE VALLEY AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT FOR SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non- profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on the non-profit's behalf; and


WHEREAS, Boys & Girls Clubs of the Casa Grande Valley is a non-profit organization that provides a safe, fun and educational place for young people by offering an after-school program during the school year and day programs during school breaks; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it would be beneficial for the citizens of the City of Maricopa and Pinal County to support the grant application of Boys & Girls Clubs of the Casa Grande Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the City of Maricopa, Arizona supports the submission of a grant application to the Ak Chin Indian Community for funding Boys & Girls Clubs of the Casa Grande Valley to provide a safe, fun and educational place for young people by offering an after-school program during the school year and day programs during school breaks and agrees to act as the designated fiscal agent for such funding.

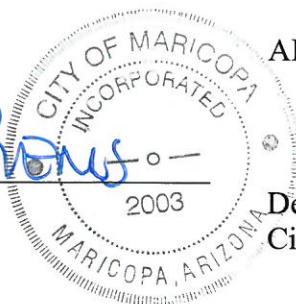


