





Alternative Strategies

- Corridor Strategies
 - Traditional corridor widening to 6 lanes
 - 6-lane Arizona Parkway Concept
 - Widening to include reversible lanes
 - HOV and/or future transit priority
 - ITS strategies
 - Alternate Modes (pedestrian & bicycle)
- Spot Improvements
 - Grade separations
 - Interchange Improvements
 - Intersection Solutions

Outreach

- Survey to solicit public input on:
 - Greatest perceived needs
 - Primary travel mode
 - Distance of travel
 - Travel purpose
 - Priorities related to mobility, crash related delays/closures, alternate modes, and property impacts
 - Potential improvements strategies
 - alternative left-turn treatments
 - grade separated intersections
 - reversible lanes
 - Median treatments
 - Signage (speed feedback, signal ahead, traveler information)
