The following project was presented:

Edwards Avenue Fencing 1. Maricopa Road to Taft Avenue Cost Estimate: \$202,763 Scope of Work: Replace the existing fence in the east & west side of the road with approximately 1,554LF of new block fence. The project is located within the Redevelopment Area and will aid the elimination of slum and blight.
