- 5.1 CUP 22-03 PUBLIC HEARING: A request by Tower Engineering Professionals (TEP) on behalf of

DISH Wireless to co-locate a wireless telecommunication facility on an existing cell tower. The site is generally located approximately one mile north of the northeast corner of N. Murphy Rd. and W. Honeycutt Rd. and just northwest of the Volkswagen facility. This project is considered an Eligible Facility Request, and falls under Section 6409 of the Spectrum Act. Discussion and Action
