On December 11, 2013, the request for proposal was released for the Maricopa Academic Scholarship Match Program with a deadline of January 30, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.

Organization Eligibility Criteria:

- · Must be a 501(c) non-profit organization,
- Must provide existing services or contributions to Maricopa residents, and
- Must provide financial proof indicating ability to match the dollar amount requested by February 28, 2014.
- · Additionally, recipients must meet the following scholarship conditions.
- · Only students living within Maricopa Unified School District's boundaries are eligible for a scholarship.
- · Community service, as defined by the non-profit organization, is required for students to be eligible for a scholarship.
- · Scholarship qualifications set forth by the non-profit organizations cannot mandate a program of study.
- · Recipient organizations must submit a report to the City detailing how the matched funds were utilized within 6 months of receipt of funds.

Two local non-profits have applied to participate in the Maricopa Academic Scholarship Match program, collectively requesting \$5,000 in matching funds.
