Discussion and Action.

The applicant, City of Maricopa, is requesting the Council initiate a Street Name Change for five (5) streets in accordance with the City Street Name Change Policy established by Resolution 14-11. The five (5) identified streets are local neighborhood roadways sharing very similar names to other roadways in the community. The similarities pose public safety concerns due to the potential for misdirection or miscommunication. Refer to staff report attachment for a full analysis.
