Pinal County requires that the City approve an IGA so that the Pinal County Recorder and Election Departments may provide voter registration and election services to the City any possible fall elections. IGA's have to be approved 120 days prior to the election. This IGA will ensure we are within that time frame should the need for an election in the fall of 2017 arise.
