A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving the designation of Applicant's Authorized Representative and Alternate Authorized Representative forms submission to the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs, which designates the city's representatives for applying for certain public assistance; and authorizing the Applicant's Authorized Representatives to execute and deliver said application on behalf of the City of Maricopa. Discussion and Action.

The City of Maricopa seeks to apply for public assistance funding under the Disaster Relief Act.

The Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs (DEMA) requires the City of Maricopa to designate an Applicant's Authorized Representative and an Alternate Applicant's Authorized Representative for the purpose of applying for and receiving public assistance funding. This resolution designates the Emergency Manager and/or Chief Financial Officer to sign and execute applications and agreements for public assistance.

Staff recommends Council approving the resolution for the designation of the Emergency Manager to act as the Applicant's Authorized Representative and the Chief Financial Officer as the Alternate Applicant's Authorized Representative.
