The Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) will entail the Maricopa Police Department assign one (1) certified sworn law enforcement officer to the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Gang and Immigration Intelligence Team Enforcement Mission (GIITEM) State Gang Task Force on a full-time basis. DPS agrees to reimburse the City of Maricopa Police Department on a monthly basis for 75% of payroll expenses to include salary, shift pay, benefits, and employee-related expenses; in addition to overtime for GIITEM related activities only.
