This request is for approval of a resolution to authorize a waiver of A.R.S. § 28-7209 which will allow the State of Arizona, by and through its Department of Transportation (ADOT) to abandon, according to law, in the near future, all of its interest in and to said right of way to the City of Maricopa for a continued public transportation use, retaining access control, if any, as necessary.
