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The intergovernmental agreement (IGA) will entail the Maricopa Police Department assign one (1) certified sworn law enforcement officer to the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Arizona Vehicle Theft Task Force (AVTTF) on a full-time basis. DPS agrees to reimburse the City of Maricopa Police Department on a quarterly basis, for 75% of the salary of the assigned police officer, phone, radio and 100% of pre-authorized Task Force related overtime hours.

This is a renewal of the original IGA which was approved by the Mayor and City Council on 1/15/2013.
