Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 12-01, the City of Maricopa is requesting review and approval of the site plan, hours of use, park rules and term/timeframe of two years for the proposed Public Dog Park. The property is located on the northeast corner of Roosevelt and Lexington Ave., within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits. More specifically parcel # 510-20-030E. Discussion and Action.

On April 23, 2012 a motion was made by Planning and Zoning Commissioner Wade to deny the Conditional Use Permit Case# CUP12-01 and was seconded by Commissioner Batt. Voice vote carried the motion 7-0.
