The Design Team, Architikon, has made significant progress in the programming and operational analysis components of the preconstruction phase. Input recieved from the public outreach to date has been compiled and the team is ready to present an update on those efforts and would like the Mayor's and Councils feedback on the Operational Analysis and recommendation on an programming option to carry forward into designing the facility.

The Project Programming is an action item. The action item is for a recommendation on the preferred Programming Option to move forward with in designing the facility. Attached is an executive summary to better explain the programming efforts and the results, as well as an explanation of the three different options that the Mayor and Council will be making a decision on.
