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As part of the City's annual maintenance program, Public Works' street maintenance division identifies heaved concrete sections causing sidewalk trip hazards and/or drainage issues. Precision Concrete Construction, Inc. uses a patented technology to prevent costlier repairs by planing concrete surface in lieu of removing and replacing concrete. This contract will allow Public Works to address necessary concrete repairs.

This item will be presented by Public Works Director/City Engineer William P. Fay.

The City Manager recommends that the Mayor and City Council approve the contract with Precision Concrete Construction, Inc. for various concrete repairs throughout the city.
