The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and possibly take action on approving an Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa Unified School District (MUSD) for the City to provide a City police officer to serve as a School Resources Officer (SRO) when the City's resources allow and MUSD will offset any cost for City usage of MUSD facilities by the amount of the cost for any SRO services provided by the City. This is an update to an Intergovernmental Agreement approved in 2015. The new agreement states when resources allow the City will provide SRO services to the district. In return, the cost of the City utilizing MUSD facilities for recreation and events will be offset by the amount of the cost for any SRO services provided by the City. The new agreement does not include MUSD use of City facilities. MUSD will be charged regular rates for use of City facilities moving forward unless otherwise negotiated.
