An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, approving and adopting an amendment to the City's Zoning Map to include a Maricopa Station Overlay District as described in zoning case ZON20-04 for the Maricopa Townsite Subdivision, within the City of Maricopa incorporated limits.
