The City recently changed its process to have a hearing officer handle employment appeals, making it necessary to eliminate the Merit Board as a council established standing board. In addition, the City Code currently allows the City Manager to refer the administration of any election held pursuant to the Meet and Confer Code to the Chairperson of the Merit Board. With the elimination of the Merit Board, the ability to refer these matters to the Chairperson should also be deleted.

Staff recommend approval of this Ordinance.
