The Mayor and City Council shall discuss and take action on recommending approval to the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control for an Application for Special Event Liquor License submitted by Pat Kieny on behalf of Native Grill & Wings for a special event known as the Copa Glow Night Market on Friday, January 14, 2022 at Copper Sky Regional Park 44345 W Martin Luther King Jr Blvd. Discussion and Action.

The State of Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control requires that an Application for Special Event License be approved by local government before submission to their office.

In preparation for the Copa Glow Night Market that is planned for January 14, 2022 at Copper Sky, Pat Kieny has applied for Councils' consideration in recommending approval for the special event liquor license.

The concept of the event is to create a craft and artisan vendor and food focused event around the theme of hot air balloons with a craft beer garden. We will be charging for parking and strongly encouraging pre-sale parking and complimentary shuttle service. This event will follow CDC-recommended guidelines for large gatherings.

Staff recommends the Mayor and City Council consider the approval to the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control for a Special Event Liquor License for the Copa Glow Night Market on January 14, 2022.
