The City Council shall discuss and take action to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Gilbert for the purpose of conducting joint law enforcement training or attending law enforcement training hosted by either party. Discussion and Action.

The City Council shall discuss and possibly approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Gilbert for the purpose of conducting joint law enforcement training or attending law enforcement training. The purpose of the Intergovernmental Agreement is to set the provisions under which the City of Gilbert and the City of Maricopa will operate to provide police recruit academy training, hosted by the City of Gilbert Police Department. The Intergovernmental Agreement provides that required training fees will be determined in a separate written agreement. The City of Gilbert will be authorized to produce and maintain academy training records for our employees who attend the Gilbert Police Academy. The City of Maricopa will provide the necessary training equipment and assistance with academy training. The Intergovernmental Agreement allows the Gilbert Police Department (Host Agency) the right to determine requirements and discipline as needed for City of Maricopa employees while they attending the Gilbert Police Academy.

The Intergovernmental Agreement will become effective the date it is adopted and shall terminate June 30, 2027. The agreement shall automatically renew for additional five (5) year terms under the same terms and conditions, including any adopted amendments in effect a the time of renewal.

Staff recommends approval of Intergovernmental Agreement with Town of Gilbert for joint law enforcement training.
